

Practical Guidelines from Feng Shui

Here are some ideas of things you can do in your small office or home office to bring good energy into your workspace. A feng shui practitioner can offer more in-depth counseling for more complex cures and solutions.

- Red flowers placed in the upper left quadrant of your office or desk can bring financial success.
- Yellow is the best color for the home office because it is peaceful and cheerful.
- Place your computer or printer in the wealth corner of your desk (upper left quadrant) in order to stir up energy and promote the value of the items you output.
- If you don't have a view outside from where you sit at your desk, hang a plant or a picture of a plant in your line of sight. It promotes peace and tranquility which will make you more relaxed and productive.
- To reduce jumbles of wires, consider purchasing an All-In-One office product which handles multiple functions including printing, scanning, and copying.
- If your desk sits on the other side of a bathroom wall, block any energy from the bathroom by hanging a thick, decorative fabric on that particular wall.
- Too much energy can be dangerous - use surge protectors to protect all of your Epson office equipment.
- Round-edged furniture stimulates creativity; squared edges promote assertive negotiations.
- Never place your desk in the middle of the room; always place it against the wall.
- If your office is at the end of a hallway, put a 100-watt bulb in the hallway to illuminate the path to your office and make it feel secure and comfortable.
